ADOPTION & PREGNANCY SUPPORT

■ UNDERSTANDING INTERNATIONAL ADOPTION1 HOUR

Learn about the process, timelines, cost, and how intercounty adoption might fit into your family. It is estimated that there are over 14 million children worldwide growing up in orphanage care who are in need of a loving and permanent family.

■ BEYOND THE BIRTH PLAN: PREPARING FOR THE EMOTIONAL SIDE OF MOTHERHOOD2 HOURS

A session for every mom-to-be; whether you're pregnant or postpartum. Understand the emotional changes that can happen during pregnancy and after birth. Learn how to spot early changes in your mood and emotions and what to do next. Lastly, learn how your emotional health shapes bonding, attachment, and your baby's development..

■ ADOPTION TODAY1 HOUR

Learn about adoption in the modern world, including benefits of open adoption, the use of positive adoption language, the adoption process, reasons why expectant parents choose adoption, and how to support someone considering creating an adoption plan for their child.

MENTAL HEALTH

■ FIRST AID CERTIFICATION5 HOURS

Learn how to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders. Receive skills needed to reach out and provide initial support to an individual and connect them to appropriate care.

■ WHOLEHEARTED4 HOURS

This class is not clinical or professional therapy. It informs participants of trauma's impact and how one might begin to move forward mentally and spiritually from a Catholic perspective. Participants learn basic and helpful trauma awareness.

FINANCIAL HEALTH

■ 7 KEYS TO FINANCIAL CONTENTMENT1.5 HOURS

This presentation seeks to give 7 direct and applicable methods to adjust how you view money, consider what is truly possible for your finances and life.

■ UNDERSTANDING CREDIT SCORES & YOUR CREDIT REPORT1 HOUR

This class gives an overview of the best tools for understanding and improving credit, such as: how your life is impacted by credit, how credit scoring works, how to build or rebuild credit, avoiding credit repair companies, and more.

■ HOMEBUYERS EDUCATION6 HOURS

Are you ready to buy a home but want to know how you can prepare? Primary topics include checking that you are ready to buy, handling finances, understanding credit, obtaining a mortgage loan, shopping for a home, and protecting your investment.

■ BASIC BUDGETING1 HOUR

Budgets are integral to having savings, which is the key to accomplishing goals and avoiding financial disaster. But, how can a budget be made to work for you? We provide several budget options so you can determine which best suits your goals.

■ CREDIT WHEN CREDIT IS DUE6 HOURS

Created by American Center for Credit Education, this course seeks to do a full analysis of every area of financial life. As an option, this course has a workbook with quizzes to test knowledge and has a notation for participant's credit report.

■ RENT SMART6 HOURS

Created by UW-Extension, Rent Smart covers every topic of rental housing so as to leave no stone unturned. Search for apartments, affordability, cooperating with landlords, affordability, lease agreements, and your rental rights.
